



Admissions Process

Thank you for your interest in Live Oak Academy. Following are the steps that are involved in our Admissions Process.

Step #1

We ask that both husband and wife read two documents posted on our website: www.liveoakacademy.org. Click on About Us.

- Our Educational Philosophy and Profile
- Confession of Faith

These two documents will give you a glimpse of who we are at Live Oak Academy.

Step #2

Would you like to visit a class? If it's not necessary, you may move on to Step #3. Otherwise, please e-mail Admissions@liveoakacademy.org and request the Pre-Application & Class Visit Form. The completed form is a precursor to a class visit and will provide us with your contact information and some academic history of your student(s). Please check our Admissions Home for class visit and shadowing dates.

Step #3

Following your visit, you may decide to fill out the Student Application. High school applicants must fill out a short essay section on the application. Please return the completed application to us with all requested attachments, including the application fee for each student.

Step #4

Assessment tests will be arranged for students who do not provide a national assessment test (Iowa Basic or Stanford Achievement Test) with their application. NOTE: In some cases, even with the IOWA or SAT provided, an assessment may be required. A \$50 assessment fee will be charged. Assessment tests for K-1 are one-on-one; other grades are tested in groups. Please clear your student's schedule for the next available test date.

Step #5

Family Interview. This in-depth interview must include both parents and applying student(s). The purpose of the interview is to help determine whether Live Oak Academy is a good fit for your family and the Academy. Following the Family Interview, your family and Live Oak Academy will prayerfully make a decision. The Academy will inform the family of acceptance and grade placement within two weeks of the Family Interview.

If classes are full, the family will be notified that the student has been placed on the wait list.
